Additional Information

One Resident tested positive over the weekend. This resident was on unrelated droplet isolation precautions and did not present an immediate danger to other residents or staff members – the affected resident had received the vaccine and a booster. All residents were immediately tested on Saturday as a precaution but there were no additional positive cases. Two additional staff members have tested positive bringing the total number of staff with positive cases to 3 – all MSCC staff members are vaccinated as a condition of employment. Once again, MSCC is on “Outbreak Status”. Residents will be tested once per week and staff members will be tested twice per week during this time. **Visitation is not affected and is still open.** All of the same rules are still in place
